

Shvet Abeer 1 Kilo Matki The purity of white

White abeer has traditionally been popular in spring festivities, but this aesthetic of purity and ecological sustainability is lost in urban India today. In Krishna temples across the country, we are still blessed with a similar abeer during the Holi sevas. It also allows you to play endlessly, wipe out the colour with this white powder, and then start all over again!

Ingredients: Natural flours and aromatic substances. Packed in earthern pot.

How to use: Use for Holi - dry colour play.

Quantity: 1 kilo

Lal Abeer 1 Kilo Matki Traditional red powder

Going back to age old ways of making natural spring powders, we present Lal Abeer, a fragrant powder comprising of only the best and purest, natural, even edible materials. Gulabjal Sprinklers Douse the party with love!


A vaulable item culled from temple paraphernalia, the rose water sprinklers can be a great aid in Holi celebrations. Spray rasikas gently with fragrant water and awaken their consciousness!

Made of brass.

How to use: Fill the sprinkler with plain or coloured rose or kewra water, and spray away.

Size: height: 10.5 inches

Ingredients: Besan (gram-flour), Haldi (turmeric), Multani mitti (fuller's earth), Neem, Sandalwood, rose petals, mint leaves.

How to use: Mix body scrub with rose-water or milk, and soak for fifteen minutes. Apply on skin and leave on till it dries, wash off scrubbing the love!

Quantity: approx. 100 grams
